As an organization, we work on several issues, topics and problems in our world. We'd like you to understand the relationship we see between our peace work and the issues/topics/problems that we connect with.

Why we are drawn to working on Iran: Pro-war forces in the media and Government have been propagandizing American citizens toward conflict with Iran since 2004. The peace movement has managed to keep the US from allowing a hot war, but only narrowly. As an anti-war organization, we remain vigilant.

What resolution are we seeking in this area: We seek diplomatic agreements resulting in verifiable inspections of Iran's nuclear program; an end to sanctions which affect predominantly impoverished and vulnerable people, and a cessation of threats of war from the United States.

NHPA connects with this issue.

We educate on this issue by: Organizing educational programs, sharing articles through our website, newsletter, and social media.

We organize on this issue by: Asking our members to consume our education materials and programming, to call their representatives, and to share information with others.

We agitate on this issue by: Lobbying our representatives for responsible policy, sponsoring and organizing public demonstrations and making public the failures of elected officials to responsibly guide our country toward a just and sustainable peace.

Our vision comes closer into being when there is a peaceful solution with Iran because: It avoids a costly and violent war and allows both countries to exist peacefully.
